International Program Admissions Procedures Checklist

Incomplete Applications will not be processed.

- Admissions Procedures Checklist
 - Application for Admission: Print and complete the Application from the school website <https://www.stoneridgeprepschools.org>. The application fee of \$250 is due with the application. ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.
 - Previous two years' official transcripts from current school translated into English.
 - Copy of current passport
 - School Administrator/Counselor Recommendation Form.
 - Teacher Recommendation Form (Math and English).
 - Standardized Test Results (e.g. Stanford, STAR, Terra Nova, PSAT, SSAT.)
 - Immunization Records
 - Guardian Information Form: Students must have a U.S. guardian. Student's parents are responsible for finding and maintaining a guardian throughout the student's time in our school.
 - Proof of Bank Statement: Bank verification of funds, translated into U.S. currency. This is a requirement of the Department of Homeland Security.
 - Interview: A personal Skype interview between applicant and International Program Director. Appointments will be arranged by the International Program Coordinator.
 - Copy of Current I-20 and Visa (IF student is transferring from a school in the U.S.)

- These items may be mailed to the Stoneridge Preparatory School Admissions Office, or emailed to admissions@stoneridgeprepschools.org titled with the applicant's name.

- Upon Acceptance:
 - Acceptance Letter.
 - New Student Orientation: Attendance is required.
 - Testing: All incoming students are required to take the Assessment Test. The Assessment Exam consists of math, vocabulary, and reading comprehension. Assessment Exams will be given during new student orientation week after the student arrives in the U.S.
 - Tuition Deposit: A non-refundable registration deposit of \$6,000 is due by the date noted on the acceptance letter. I-20 will be issued only when the deposit has been received.
 - Tuition & Fees: Tuition is paid in advance and is due when the student arrives in the U.S. All fees and international tuition are non-refundable, and parents are obligated for payment of the annual tuition in full. Please refer to the tuition schedule for a list of costs.

- When the student arrives in the U.S., he/she must purchase and provide proof of health insurance.
